

Rules for majors

Coaches may use an EP {extra player} in the batting line-up. All substitution must be put in by the 3rd inning. They must play at least 2 innings in the field and 1 at bat. Starters may enter in the game after this obligation has been met. They must reenter in the same spot in the batting order. If the substitutions do not get their required playing time and their at bat they will start the next game. Coaches will still have the option of batting their entire line-up, but both teams do not have to do it, even if they are playing each other. The EP may play any position in the field. He or she must play in the field 2 innings and they and the person they switch with will remain in the batting order they where they started. The person who started in the field is NOT considered out of the game.

No pitcher may pitch more than 6 innings per week. The week goes from Monday to Sunday. If a pitcher pitches more than 2 innings, then 2 calendar days rest must be observed between pitching assignments. If a pitcher leaves the mound in the middle of an inning they can not go back on the mound during the game. If they after a complete inning they can go back on the mound. Each inning they pitch count as an inning as far as the days of rest count {if they pitch the 1st 2 and come back and pitch the last 2 innings it counts as 4 inning for that game and that day and week.)

For the playoffs pitching will be 6 innings every two games.

Batter may not run on dropped third strike.

Baseball must use catcher's mitt. Softball may use regular glove.

Softball will use 12" ball and all helmets must have faceguard. No metal cleats are allowed.

Try to make up games as soon as possible.

Home team will provide umpire.

Home team will provide one new ball and a good used ball for a back-up.

No inning may start after 8:pm or after 2 hours.

Any player deliberately running into the catcher will be ejected from the game.

A runner may leave off the base after the ball crosses the home plate.

Players may not fake a tag without the ball.

Bunting is allowed.

There is a 10-run rule after 4 innings during the regular season and the playoffs.

In the playoffs, a team will bat nine and make substitutions in the normal way. All team player must play two innings in the field and have at least one at bat.

Coaches remember that the game is for the kids. The way that you act is the way the parents and kids will act. We should all try to win, but not at the expense of the weaker players. Remember they are part of the team so please treat them fairly. They all pay the same registration fees. If they did not want to play they would not have signed up.
